

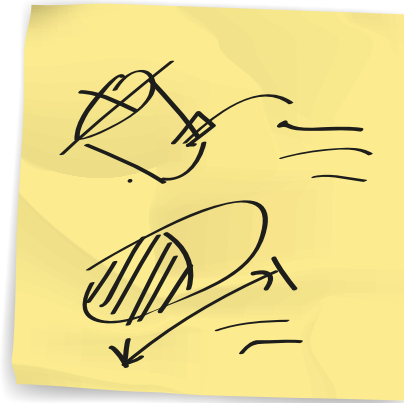

Sheffield, 1st & 2nd July 2013

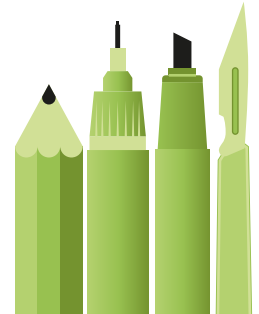
